Baxter Meadows HOA falls under the City of Bozeman's dog restraintment laws. It basically states that all dogs need to be kept on a leash when not on your own private property. We are aware that many of your dogs are well behaved, friendly pooches, but please be sensitive to those residents who may not love dogs, may be afraid of them, or has a dog on a leash that may not be as friendly. If you see a dog running free, you are encouraged to call the Bozeman City Animal Control officer at (406)582-2000.

Along with dog walking there will most certainly be a pet waste problem in common areas and neighbor's yards. Pick up after your dog, it is the law. This is your community along with many other residents and we all want our families to enjoy the wonderful common space amenities that are provided. Keeping these areas free of pet waste is an important issue and can be appreciated by all homeowners.
